A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMERICAN CANYON, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE IN RESOLUTION 2004-11 ADDING UTILITY BILLING FEES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 66000 of the Government Code, the City Council of the City of American Canyon in 2002 adopted Ordinance 2002-01 establishing the Master Fee Schedule to recover costs associated with services provided to the public for specific services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the proposed changes are necessary so that the City may recover its costs in providing services to meet the needs of utility customers; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 66016 of the Government Code the City of American Canyon has held a duly noticed Public Hearing to consider the recommendations of City Staff; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered all testimony given at the Public Hearing on April 1, 2004, regarding approval of a proposed Resolution to amend Resolution 2004-11.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE City Council of the City of American Canyon hereby finds and determines that Resolution 2004-26 is amended to read as follows:

Section 7. Sewer Industrial Discharge Fees

Significant Industrial User Annual Permit:

Significant Industrial Users shall pay an annual fee of \$1,430 for the administration of their annual permits, annual sampling and reporting, state audits, and regional reports.

Significant Industrial User Inspection Fee:

Significant Industrial Users shall pay the actual cost (salary and benefits plus 54%) for the costs associated with Public Works Department inspections, inspection reports, and monthly review of discharges. A deposit of \$4,600 shall be required prior to the issuance of the annual permit. Any amount unused in one year may be carried forward to the next year.
